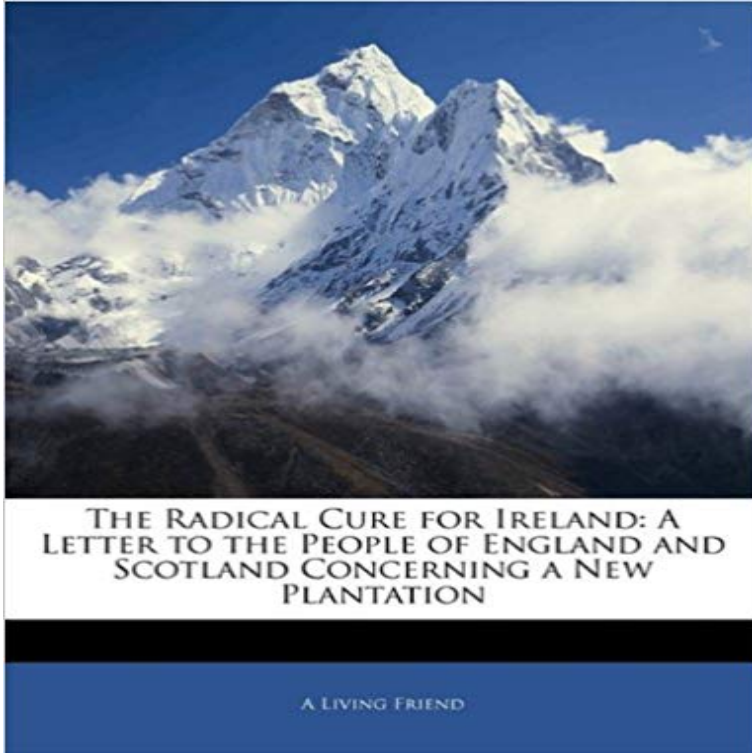


# The Radical Cure for Ireland: A Letter to the People of England and Scotland Concerning a New Plantation
