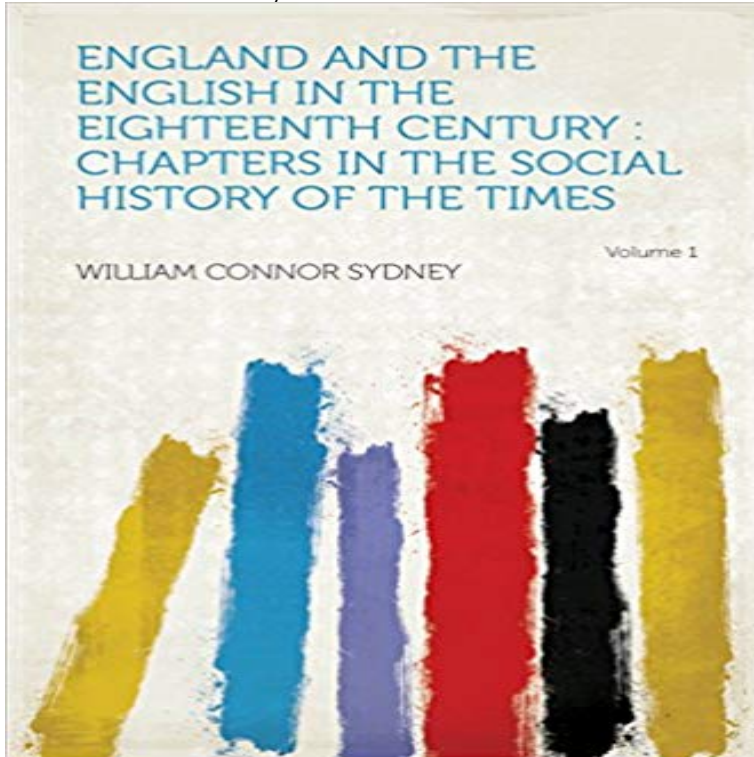


# England and the English in the Eighteenth Century : Chapters in the Social History of the Times
